
## **Internet Explorer: Exercise 3**


## In this exercise:

- 1. Open the program Microsoft Internet Explorer.
- **2.** Click in the address bar.
- **3. Press** the **DELETE** key to erase everything in the address bar.
- **4. Type** www.hmong.org
- **5. Press** the **ENTER** key.
- 6. Click on FAVORITES.
- 7. Click on ADD TO FAVORITES.
- **8.** Click in the NAME field.




- **9.** Type a name to describe this website.
- 10. Click on OK. You have added this website to a list of favorite websites on your computer.
- **11.** Click in the address bar.
- **12. Erase** what is in the address bar.
- **13. Type** www.teacherweb.com/mn/hap/tecs
- **14. Press** the **ENTER** key.
- 15. Click on the FAVORITES menu.

16. Click on the link that you added to the list.




- 17. What is the URL of the website you're looking at now?\_
- **18.** Go to www.google.com.
- 19. Search for websites about English Language Games.

**31.** Click on one of the websites you have added.






**42. Click** on the **Google.com** folder.

- **50.** At the bottom of the box where it says **Days to Keep Pages in History**, change the number to 7.
- 51. Click on APPLY. Click on OK.
- **52.** Close the control panel window.
